## **Pets Policy - February 2016**

### **Dogs**

Knowing how hard it can be to take you "best friend" with you we are happy to welcome well-behaved dogs but it is on the understanding that you want to have your dog with you and will take it out with you during the day.

Please let us know when booking if you would like to bring your dog. We charge a nominal £30.00 per dog to allow for the additional cleaning that is usually required on departure. We also request a deposit of £ 50.00 in case of damage to any furnishings.

You will need to bring everything you need for your dog - food, feeding bowls and bedding. Please keep you dog off the beds and furniture.

### **Please scoop the poop!**

As a responsible dog owner, we are sure that you will clear up after your dog. To make life easier for you, we have provided a "dog loo" and poop scoop for disposal of faeces. You will find these between the timber chalet and oil tanks,

next to the rotary clothes line. Please use biodegradable bags or put the faeces directly into the loo and please return the scoop after use.

**PLEASE DO NOT** put faeces in the household waste or any other bin.

### **Please keep your dog on a lead**

Please keep your dog on a lead whilst on the Church View Estate - many of the ducks and chickens are free range and have a tendency to wander around the grounds. Note that the raised area behind the small holding is part of our estate and the alpacas may graze this area so please keep your dog on a lead here too. Owen will advise you of areas that are safe to exercise your dog if required.

### **Your dog and other residents**

Not everyone likes dogs and other residents may prefer not to get to know your dog. In particular, be mindful that young children may be frightened by dogs regardless of how friendly you think they are (the dogs that is).

Please try to keep your dog quiet.

Dogs should be kept away from the childrens' play area please because of the risk of toxocara infection.

### **Your dog and our dogs**

Currently we have two cocker spaniels as part of the Church View animal managery: Codie the older who is friends with everyone and George, the younger and more noisy of them. To date they have had a good relationship with all the human and canine visitors....if you have any reservations please ask and we hopefully can introduce your dogs with ours.
